Purchase price of all our pups is \$500. Adult dogs working as LGD's will be priced by private party agreement. This contract must be signed and returned with the deposit to reserve a pup/dog. Pups /dogs must be paid for in full before leaving the farm.

Terms follow....

Payment information:

To reserve a pup/dog a deposit of \$100 is required. Deposits are non-refundable but may be transferred to another litter if no puppies were born of the gender you have requested. Once you have selected a pup... the deposit is no longer transferable. The deposit will hold the selected pup until 8 weeks of age. Or the adult dog for one week to make arrangements for pickup. If the pup / dog is not picked up or can't be shipped because of weather, an additional fee of \$5 per day will be charged to cover board and additional care. Shipping fees are the responsibility of the buyer. Shipping will be arranged from Scottsbluff Regional Airport by the breeder.

Health Guarantee:

The pup is guaranteed to have regular deworming, all shots recommended to age of puppy /dog when picked up. All adult LGD's will be spayed or neutered prior to purchase. The pup will be started on premium quality dry food. Pups must be fed a low protein diet (23% or less) from the age of 3 – 4 months... this will help to prevent hot spots and joint problems as the pup grows and matures. We suggest pups /dogs have a health exam from a licensed Veterinarian within 5 business days. Should a long term health concern be discovered, buyer has 2 days to contact the breeder and return the pup/dog with a typed and signed (by Veterinarian) statement for a full refund of money. Statement must have the Veterinarians contact information included. Failure to have a health exam within 5 business days of purchase will void this option.

Return Guarantee:

If at any time in the life of you pup/dog you are unable to keep it, we will either take the pup/dog back, do everything possible to help you re-home the pup/dog, or help home the pup/dog through a reputable Great Pyrenees Rescue League. We will not reimburse the buyer for the initial cost of pup/dog, training or other expenses incurred prior to the return of the pup/dog. Delivery costs or shipping are the responsibility of the buyer. The pup/dog must be current on vaccines and worming and accompanied by a Veterinarian signed record of such.

Limited Use Agreement:

Price maybe negotiated provided the buyer agrees to never use the pup for any purpose other than companion or livestock guardian. This agreement includes spay/neuter of the pup and the registration papers will include the limited use restrictions.

Shipping:

The buyer understands that once a pup or dog is delivered to the departing airport, the breeder is no longer responsible for it's safety, health of well being. It is the choice, solely of the buyer to ship their pup/dog and the breeders are not responsible for any problems incurred during the shipping or after as a result of shipping.
